Responsibilities:

- Collects, processes, and handles blood or other biological specimen according to established procedures, instruct patients in the proper collection of samples
- Performs a variety of clinical laboratory tests in the areas of hematology, microbiology, immunology, clinical chemistry, and analysis such as assigned conditions.
- Quantitative and qualitative chemical analysis of body fluids e.g. urine, blood, and spinal fluids, perform blood counts using a microscope
- Conduct blood tests for transfusion purposes. It may drain blood from the patient's fingers, ear lobes, or vein observing principles of asepsis to obtain blood samples
- Performs quality control on test results ensuring validity and accuracy
- Keeps records and reports on results according to established procedures
- Practice safety environment and infectious control methods
- Do weekly malaria reports and monthly laboratory reports whenever required.

Qualifications:

- Degree/ Diploma in Medical Laboratory Science.
- At least 5 years' experience in a clinical laboratory.
- He or she must be registered with KMLTTB with a current valid practicing license
- Strong attention to detail and accuracy in laboratory procedures and data interpretation.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills to collaborate effectively with healthcare professionals.
